ENVS-4003. Capstone Seminar. This course is designed to provide students with an opportunity to apply the knowledge and skills acquired in their previous coursework to a real-world environmental problem. Students will work in teams to identify a problem, conduct research, and develop a solution. The course will culminate in a final presentation to a panel of judges. Prerequisites: ENVS 3013, ENVS 3023.

ENVS-4006. Work-Study Project

ENVS-4006. Work-Study Project. This course provides students with an opportunity to gain hands-on experience in the environmental field. Students will be placed in a work-study position at a local environmental organization or government agency. The course will focus on the student's work experience and the application of environmental science concepts to the workplace. Prerequisites: ENVS 3013, ENVS 3023.
