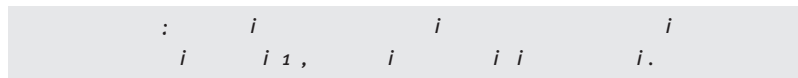

CRIM-1013. Introduction to Criminology
