Bachelor of Applied Arts in Gerontology Degree Requirements

To graduate with a Bachelor of Applied Arts in Gerontology, the student must complete the following requirements at St. Thomas University: the Bachelor of Applied Arts in Gerontology diploma at the Nebraska Council on Higher Education (NBCC). Upon completion of the NBCC Bachelor of Applied Arts in Gerontology diploma, the student will be awarded 30 credit hours toward a Bachelor of Applied Arts in Gerontology. The student must also complete the following requirements:

1. *First Year at St. Thomas University (30 credit hours)*

The student will take 30 credit hours. The student must take the following courses: English I, English II, History I, History II, and three elective courses.

2. *Second Year at St. Thomas University (30 credit hours)*

The student will take 30 credit hours. The student must complete the following courses: Gerontology 1013 and 1023 (prerequisite: March 2013, to August 2023), 6 credit hours in Gerontology electives, and 15 credit hours in the electives. 3. *Third Year at St. Thomas University (30 credit hours)*

The student will take 30 credit hours. The student must complete the following courses: Gerontology 309 and 310 (prerequisite: Gerontology 1013 and 1023), 6 credit hours in Gerontology electives, and 15 credit hours in the electives. Upon completion of the NBCC diploma in Gerontology, the student will be awarded the St. Thomas University Bachelor of Applied Arts in Gerontology.
