

Double Major in French and Spanish and Latin in American Studies

Students who complete the Double Major in French and Spanish and Latin in American Studies will receive a Bachelor of Arts degree with a concentration in French and Spanish and Latin in American Studies. This program is designed for students who are interested in the study of French and Spanish and Latin American literature, culture, and history. The program includes courses in French and Spanish language, literature, and culture, as well as courses in Latin American studies. Students who complete this program will be well-prepared for careers in education, publishing, and other fields related to the study of French and Spanish and Latin American literature and culture.

Double Major in French and Spanish and Latin in American Studies Requirements

Students who complete the Double Major in French and Spanish and Latin in American Studies must complete the following requirements: (36 credits) French and Spanish and Latin American Studies courses, including French and Spanish language courses, French and Spanish literature courses, and Latin American studies courses. Students must also complete a minimum of 30 credits of general education requirements. The program is designed to be completed in four years. AI-3043. *Algebra*

Algebra is a branch of mathematics that deals with the study of mathematical symbols and the rules for manipulating these symbols. Latin

IA-1013. *Latin*
