SOCI-1006. Introduction to Sociology

Grade level: Freshman

SOCI-2743. Special Topics

This course is designed to provide students with an opportunity to explore a special topic in sociology. The topic will be chosen by the instructor and will vary from semester to semester. The course will include a combination of lecture, discussion, and reading assignments. Prerequisite: SOCI 2033.

SOCI-3023. Contemporary Sociological Theory

This course examines the major theoretical perspectives in contemporary sociology. The course will include a combination of lecture, discussion, and reading assignments. Prerequisite: SOCI 2033.

SOCI-3033. Seminar in Research Strategies

This course is designed to provide students with an opportunity to explore research strategies in sociology. The course will include a combination of lecture, discussion, and reading assignments. Prerequisite: SOCI 2033.

SOCI-3153. Sociology of War

SOCI-3173. Women and Education
