Registration is the process whereby students choose courses for an academic session and con rm this selection of courses with the Registrar's O ce. The University o ers courses in di erent periods of time or sessions:

Academic Year September to April
Semester One September to December
Semester Two January to April

Intersession April to June
Summer Session July to August

Registration for the academic year (September to April) takes place in the spring for continuing and returning students, and from April to August for new rst-year students. Con rmation of this registration must be accomplished by arranging payment of tuition fees by the appropriate deadline.
