

# School of Social Work

1. A 120 credit hour Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) degree is available to students who have completed a minimum of 60 credit hours of university course work with a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 based on university course work completed after graduation (a minimum of 15 credit hours). Normally, these courses will be chosen from the Social Sciences and Humanities, and will be taken at the second-year level or higher, and must be completed prior to application. Applicants must meet all other requirements.

## A. Admission To Bachelor of Social Work – Post-Degree

### Prerequisites

1. A 120 credit hour Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) degree is available to students who have completed a minimum of 60 credit hours of university course work with a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 based on university course work completed after graduation (a minimum of 15 credit hours). Normally, these courses will be chosen from the Social Sciences and Humanities, and will be taken at the second-year level or higher, and must be completed prior to application. Applicants must meet all other requirements.

*\*An applicant with a bachelor's degree who does not meet the grade point average requirement may be considered for admission two years after graduation if the applicant has earned a grade point average of at least 3.0 based on university course work completed after graduation (a minimum of 15 credit hours). Normally, these courses will be chosen from the Social Sciences and Humanities, and will be taken at the second-year level or higher, and must be completed prior to application. Applicants must meet all other requirements.*

2. A 60 credit hour Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) degree is available to students who have completed a minimum of 30 credit hours of university course work with a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 based on university course work completed after graduation (a minimum of 15 credit hours). Normally, these courses will be chosen from the Social Sciences and Humanities, and will be taken at the second-year level or higher, and must be completed prior to application. Applicants must meet all other requirements.

*Note: Applicants who do not satisfy these minimum academic requirements are not considered further in the selection process.*

3. A 60 credit hour Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) degree is available to students who have completed a minimum of 30 credit hours of university course work with a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 based on university course work completed after graduation (a minimum of 15 credit hours). Normally, these courses will be chosen from the Social Sciences and Humanities, and will be taken at the second-year level or higher, and must be completed prior to application. Applicants must meet all other requirements.



6. **BSW** **5116** **General Social Work Practice** (M I & II) (3.0)

This course provides an opportunity for students to gain practical experience in the field of social work. Students will be assigned to a placement site where they will work under the supervision of a licensed social worker. The placement will be for a minimum of 150 hours.

7. **BSW** **5023** **Professional Social Work** (3.0)

8. **BSW** **5036** **Therapeutic Social Work Practice** (6.0)
