



SCWK-3813. Native Cultural Identity and Cultural Survival (NATI)

C3, F3, N, H, NATI 1006, SOC1006, F

**SCWK-5012. Field Instruction III (K)**

T. This course is a continuation of the field instruction experience for students in the BS in Social Work program. Students will continue to develop their professional skills and knowledge through a supervised field placement. Prerequisite: SCWK 5011. Corequisite: SCWK 5013. Total Credits: 12.

**SCWK-5013. Group Work Theory and Design (F)**

T. This course provides students with a theoretical and practical understanding of group work. Students will explore the history, development, and various models of group work. The course also covers the design and implementation of group interventions. Prerequisite: SCWK 5011. Corequisite: SCWK 5012. Total Credits: 3.

**SCWK-5023. The Profession of Social Work in Context (F) (K)**

T. This course examines the social work profession in its historical and contemporary context. Students will explore the values, ethics, and standards of the profession. The course also addresses the role of social workers in various settings and the impact of social policy on the profession. Prerequisite: SCWK 5011. Corequisite: SCWK 5012. Total Credits: 3.

**SCWK-5036. Theory of Social Work Practice I (F) (K)**

T. This course introduces students to the theoretical foundations of social work practice. Students will explore various theoretical perspectives and their application to social work practice. The course also covers the role of the social worker in the assessment and intervention process. Prerequisite: SCWK 5011. Corequisite: SCWK 5012. Total Credits: 3.

**SCWK-5046. Theory for Social Work Practice II (F) (K)**

T. This course continues the exploration of theoretical foundations of social work practice. Students will examine the relationship between theory and practice, and how theoretical perspectives inform social work interventions. Prerequisite: SCWK 5036. Total Credits: 3.

**SCWK-5053. Field Instruction I (F)**

T. This course is the first of three field instruction courses for students in the BS in Social Work program. Students will gain hands-on experience in a supervised field placement, applying theoretical knowledge to practice. Prerequisite: SCWK 5011. Corequisite: SCWK 5012. Total Credits: 12.

**SCWK-5089. Field Instruction II (F)**

T. This course is the second of three field instruction courses for students in the BS in Social Work program. Students will continue to develop their professional skills and knowledge through a supervised field placement. Prerequisite: SCWK 5036. Total Credits: 9.
