INTR-2003. Preparing for International Living and Work Experience

This course is designed to prepare students for international living and work experience. It covers topics such as cultural differences, language barriers, and the challenges of living and working in a foreign country. Students will learn how to adapt to a new environment and how to communicate effectively in a multicultural setting.

INTR-2016. Reflecting on International Living and Work Experience

This course is designed to help students reflect on their international living and work experience. It provides a structured framework for students to analyze their experiences, identify their strengths and weaknesses, and develop a plan for future growth. Students will be encouraged to share their insights and learn from each other's experiences.

INTR-3003. Experiential Community-Based Internship

This course provides students with a hands-on learning experience through a community-based internship. Students will work closely with a community organization or agency, applying their academic knowledge and skills to real-world challenges. The course is designed to foster a sense of social responsibility and civic engagement. (1) Credit. Prerequisites: Completion of at least one semester of college-level work.

INTR-4003. Interdisciplinary Honours Workshop

This workshop is designed for students who are interested in pursuing interdisciplinary research. It provides a platform for students to explore complex issues from multiple perspectives, drawing on knowledge from different disciplines. The workshop includes guest speakers, seminars, and collaborative projects. (1) Credit. Prerequisites: Completion of at least two semesters of college-level work.

INTR-4016. Interdisciplinary Honours Thesis

This thesis is a culminating project for students who have completed the Interdisciplinary Honours Program. It allows students to conduct original research that integrates knowledge from multiple disciplines. The thesis is supervised by a faculty advisor and is defended in a public forum. (1) Credit. Prerequisites: Completion of all required coursework for the Interdisciplinary Honours Program.
